Day 01

- Arrive at Manali in the morning
- A scenic drive from Manali to Jobra (3000m)
- Trek to Chikka Campsite (3078m)
- O/N Chikka Campsite

Day 02

- Trek from Chikka Camp(3078m) to Balu Ka Ghera (3783m)
- O/N Balu Ka Ghera

Day 03

- Trek from Balu Ka Ghera (3783m) via Hampta Pass to Shea Goru camp (3900m)
- O/N Shea Goru Camp

Day 04

- Trek from Shea Goru camp (3900m) to Chatru (3320m)
- Drive to Chandratat and back to Chatru campsite
- O/N Chatru Campsite

Day 05

- Drive from Chatru camp via Atal Tunnel to Manali

DAY 1


Arrive at Manali in the morning. Embark on a scenic drive from Manali to Jobra (3000m). Same day trek to Chikka Campsite (3078m). O/N Chikka Campsite



We'll depart from Manali early morning for a 2–3 hour drive, getting to know each other with games and soothing music along the way. The route winds through beautiful villages, valleys, and forests with stunning mountain views. By afternoon, we'll reach Jobra village and begin our trek to Chikka campsite. The easy, well-maintained trail starts with a gentle climb through deodar forests, taking around 2–3 hours. Chikka offers breathtaking Himalayan views and a peaceful atmosphere to relax. After freshening up, we'll gather under the stars for music, conversations, or simply enjoying the silence. After dinner, we'll settle in for a good night's rest before continuing our adventure.

DAY 2


Trek from Chikka Camp(3078m) to Balu Ka Ghera (3783m). O/N Balu Ka Ghera



Rise and shine, Firgun Family — it's the first day of our trek! Today's moderate-to-difficult hike takes us through meadows, boulder fields, and rocky terrain, offering both challenges and incredible rewards. We'll trek at a comfortable pace, taking breaks to soak in the views of majestic peaks, lush valleys, and gurgling streams. After 5–6 hours, we'll reach Balu Ka Ghera, a beautiful campsite surrounded by green meadows and towering mountains. In the evening, we'll relax over snacks, share stories and laughter, and end the day with a hearty dinner, recharging for tomorrow's big adventure.

DAY 3

Trek from Balu Ka Ghera (3783m) via Hampta Pass to Shea Goru camp (3900m). O/N Shea Goru Camp



We'll start early with tea and breakfast before beginning a steep climb toward Hampta Pass. The trail is challenging, with loose scree and rocky paths, but we'll move carefully and support each other along the way. Reaching the pass offers a breathtaking contrast — lush green Kullu Valley on one side and the stark, barren landscape of Lahaul on the other. After soaking in the views and capturing memories, we'll descend to Shea Goru, a trekker's paradise. Once at the campsite, we'll rest and later celebrate our achievement with chai, snacks, and a sky full of stars — a day you'll remember forever.

DAY 4

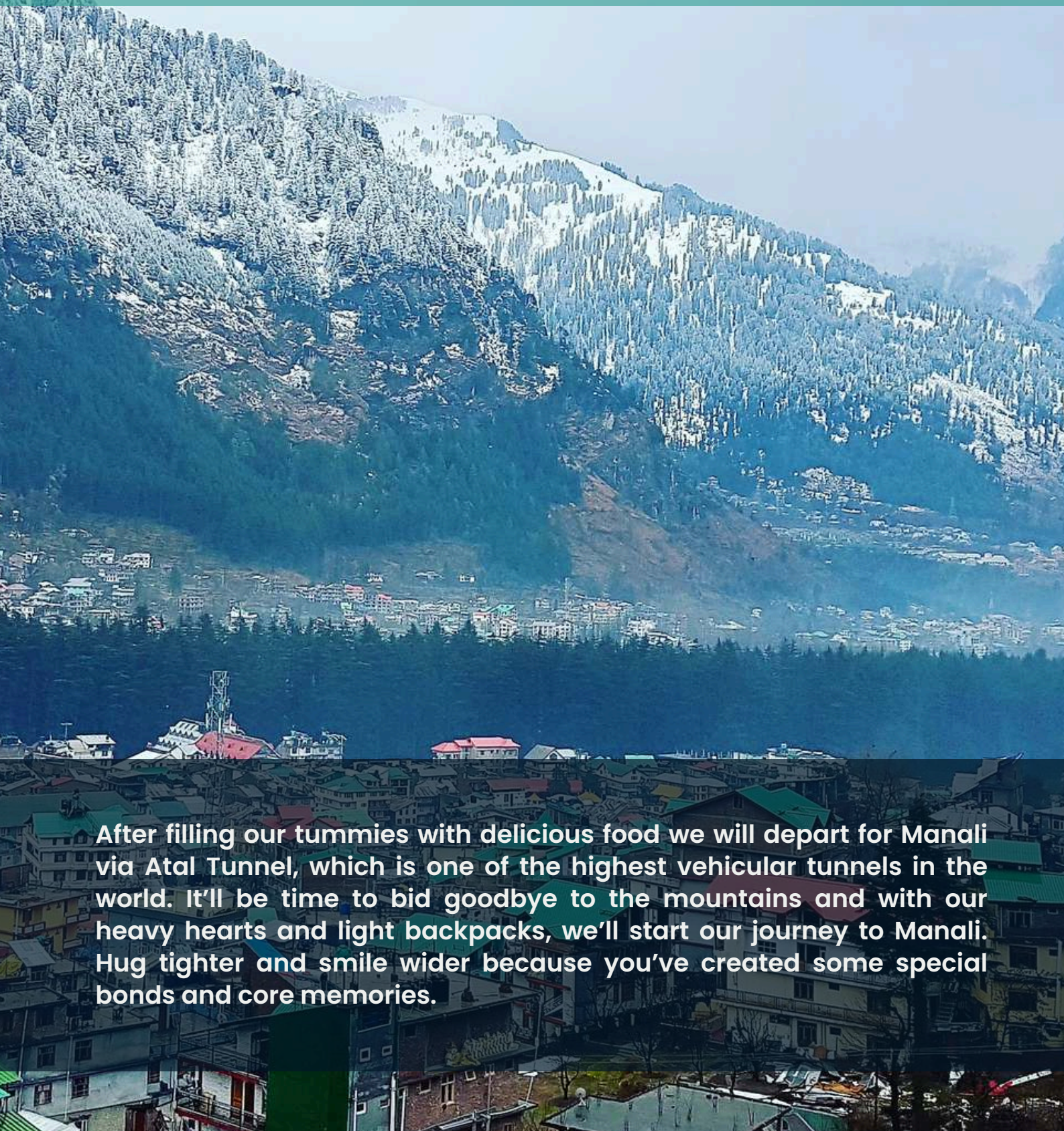
Trek from Shea Goru camp (3900m) to Chatru (3320m) and drive to Chandratal and back to Chatru campsite. O/N Chatru Campsite



After a nourishing breakfast, we'll begin our final descent from Shea Goru to Chatru, trekking through stunning landscapes as we transition from high meadows to the cold desert of Spiti Valley. The Chandra River flows alongside parts of the trail, adding to the serene beauty. After reaching Chatru and having lunch, we'll drive to the breathtaking Chandratal Lake (weather permitting). Surrounded by stark mountains and shimmering turquoise waters, Chandratal feels like a dreamscape — a perfect place to pause, reflect, and soak in nature's magic. Afterward, we'll return to our campsite at Chatru with hearts full and memories made.

DAY 5

Drive from Chatru camp via Atal Tunnel to Manali.



After filling our tummies with delicious food we will depart for Manali via Atal Tunnel, which is one of the highest vehicular tunnels in the world. It'll be time to bid goodbye to the mountains and with our heavy hearts and light backpacks, we'll start our journey to Manali. Hug tighter and smile wider because you've created some special bonds and core memories.

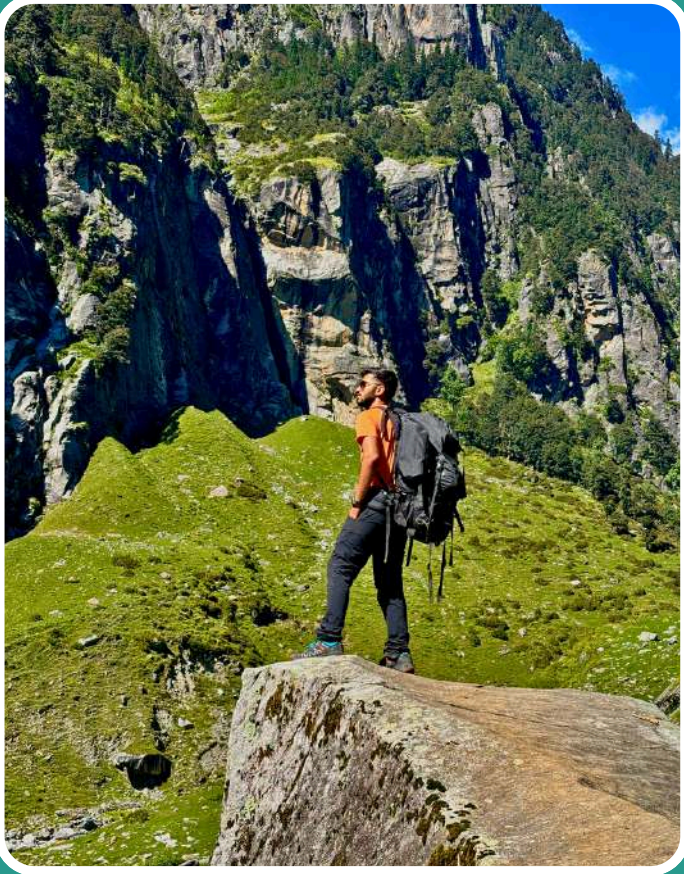
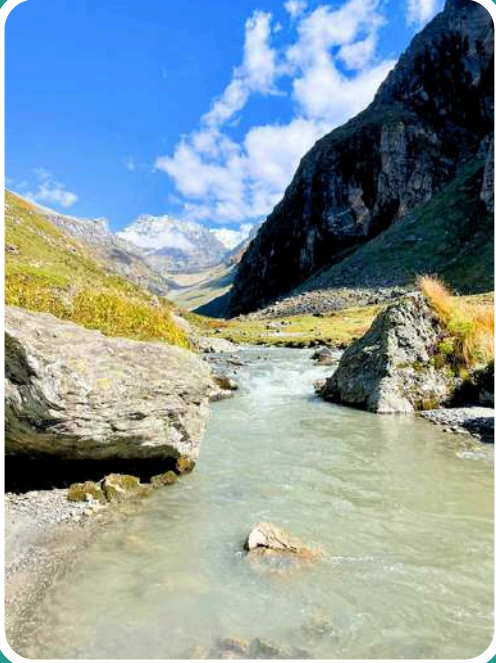

- Power banks: We won't have charging portals everywhere so keep at least 1 power bank fully charged and handy, how else would you cover the beautiful landscapes
