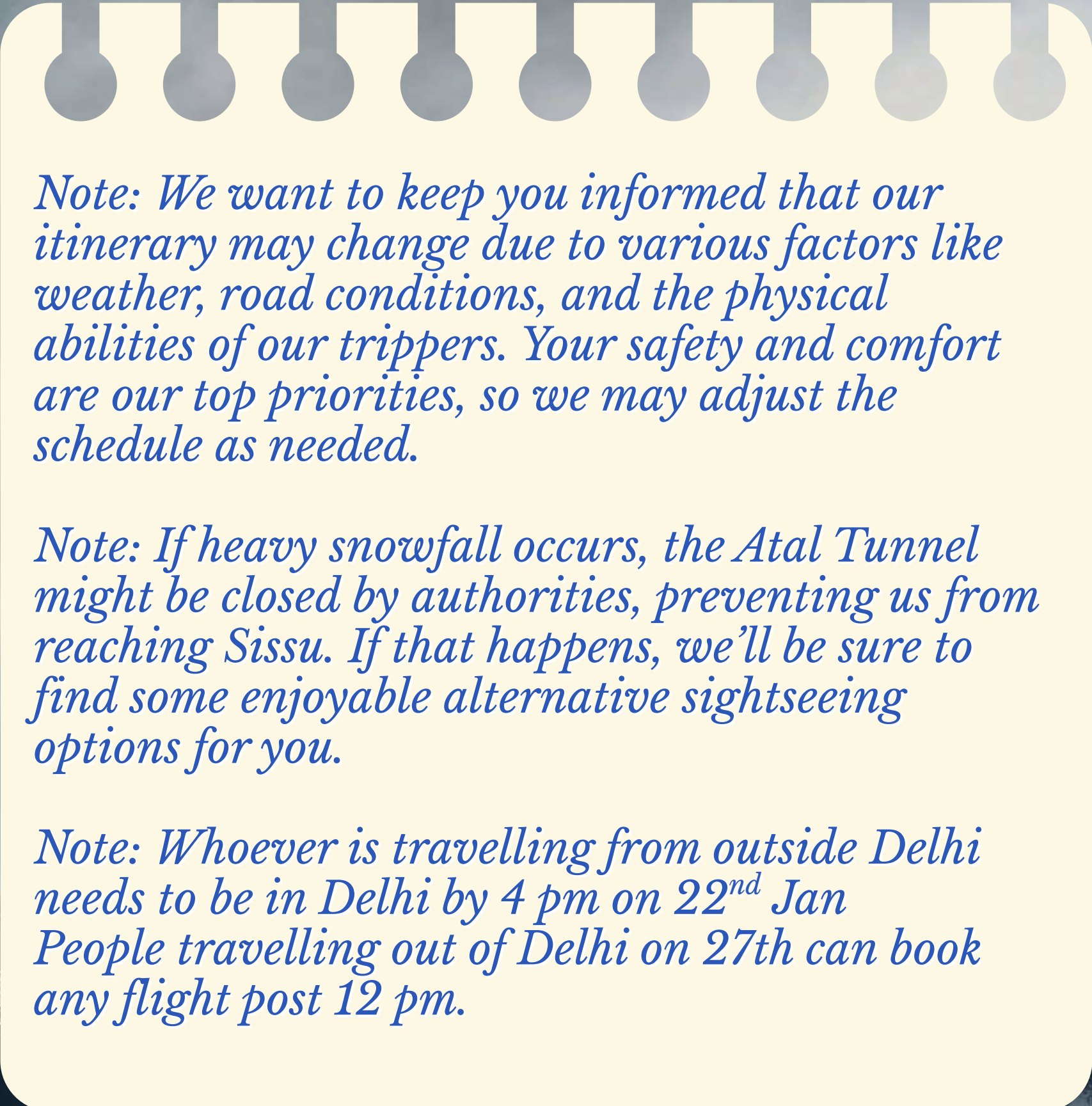

*Drive through the Atal Tunnel to Sissu village, visit its lake and waterfall, then return to Manali.*



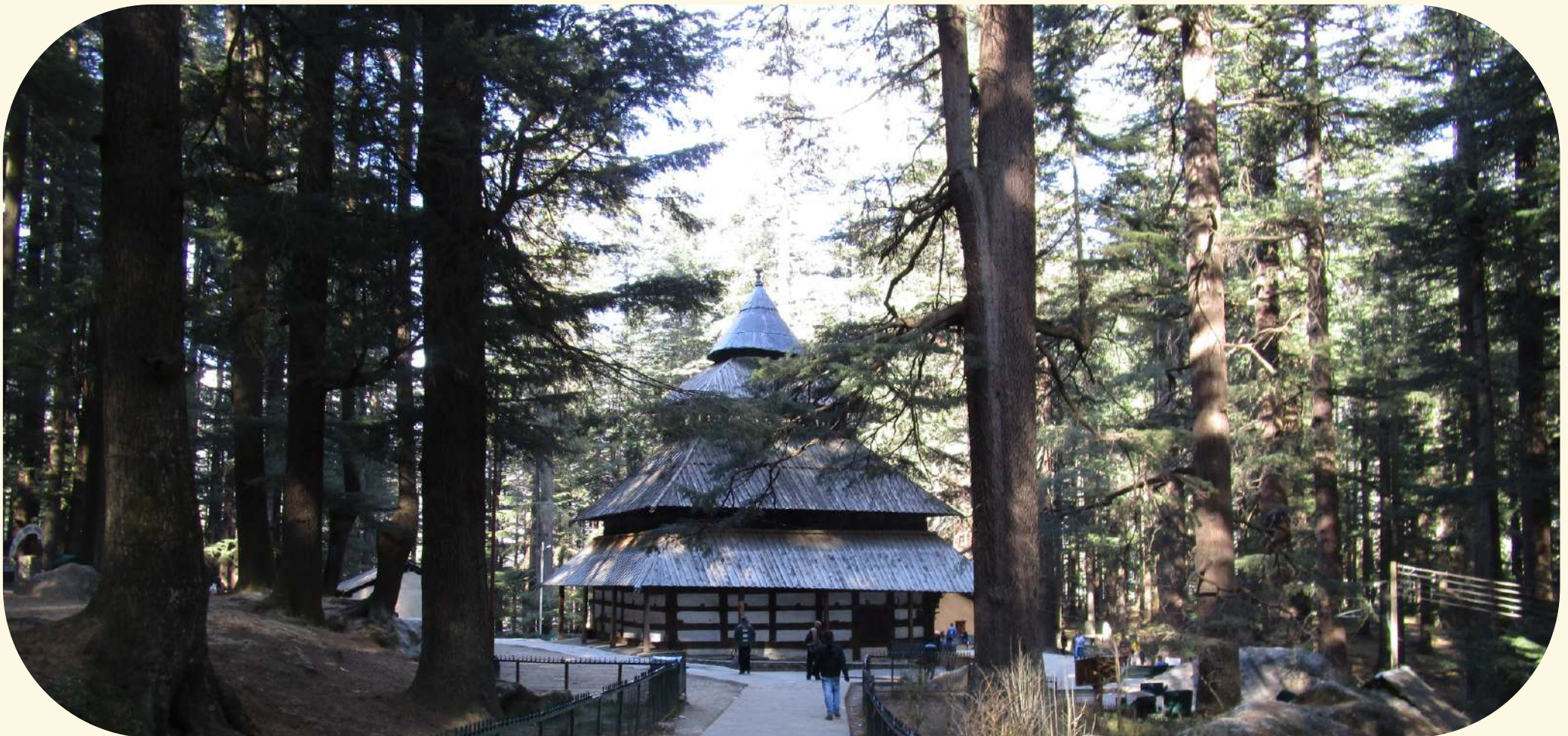
*End the day café hopping in Old Manali - warm vibes, great food, and cheerful conversations.*

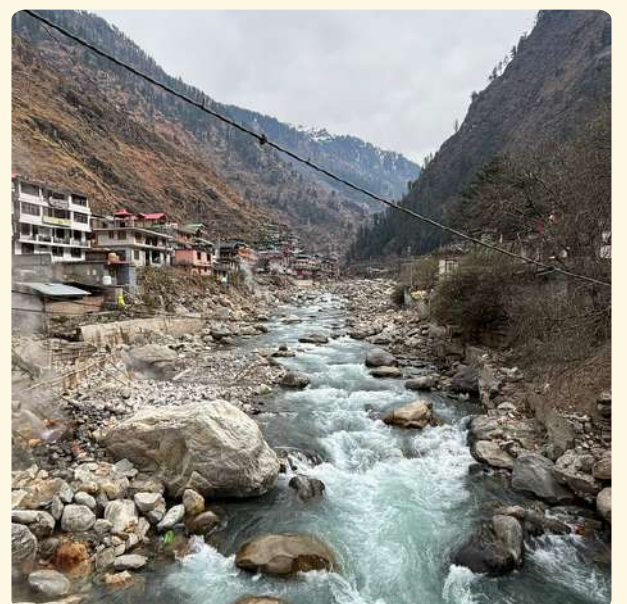

# THINGS TO CARRY

- *ID Proof: Carry an original photo ID when you come for the trip. It can be either your Passport, Aadhar Card, or Voter ID. This is Mandatory.*
- *Comfortable clothes*
- *1–2 thick jackets*
- *Carry trekking/sports shoes: Carry trekking or good sports shoes for the Jogini Falls hike and snow activities at Solang Valley.*
- *Moisturizer, sanitizer, lip balm*
- *2–3 winter layers to beat the cold*
- *Hand gloves*
- *Muffler, neck warmer*
- *Water bottle: Carry at least one reusable water bottle.*
- *Energy bars, dry fruits, Electral, ORS, chocolates*



# THINGS TO CARRY

- *Sunscreen and sun lotion (SPF 50+ is advisable):*
- *Snacks: Carry chocolates or energy bars for quick energy boosts, along with other light snacks for the journey.*
- *Personal Medications: Don't forget to pack any medications you might need during the trip.*
- *Power banks: We won't have charging points everywhere, so keep at least one power bank fully charged and handy you'll want to capture every moment in the snow!*
- *Party Outfit: Keep one nice outfit for the New Year's Eve celebration in Kasol.*
- *Cash: ATMs and online payments may not always work in remote areas, so carry some cash just in case.*

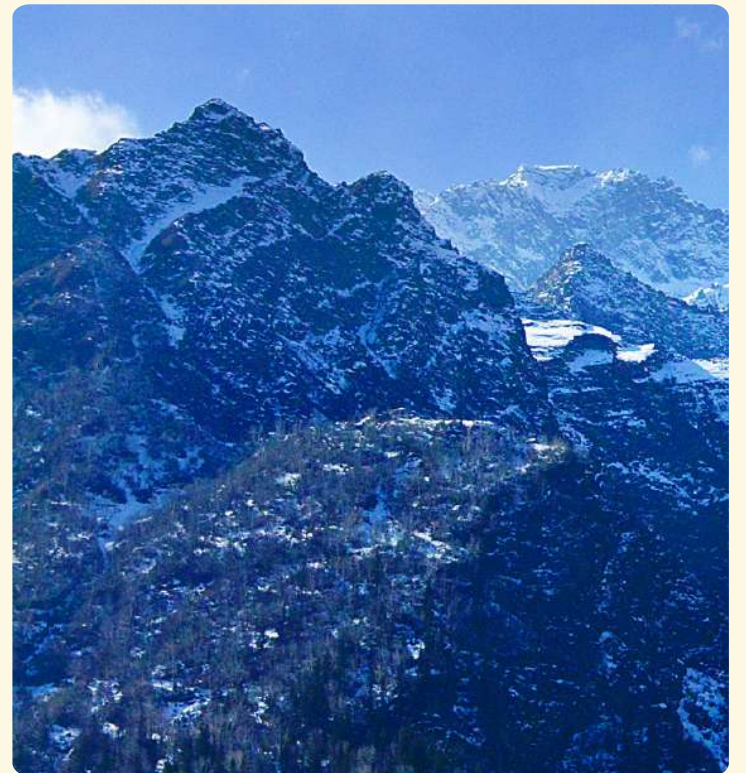
