

As the day winds down, enjoy the energy of Dotonbori, making the most of your last evening in Osaka.






- Flip-Flops: For use in accommodations or leisure.
- Sundresses/Light Clothing: For warmer days.
- Swimwear: If you plan to enjoy onsen or hotel pools.
- Sun Protection: Hats, caps, and sunglasses.
- Waterproof Bag/Dry Bag: For rainy days or visits to onsen.
- Water Bottle: To stay hydrated; we encourage avoiding single-use plastics.
- Hand Sanitizers: For cleanliness on the go.
