
Day 6- The toughest day. Transfer to Almaty International Airport to fly back to your city.



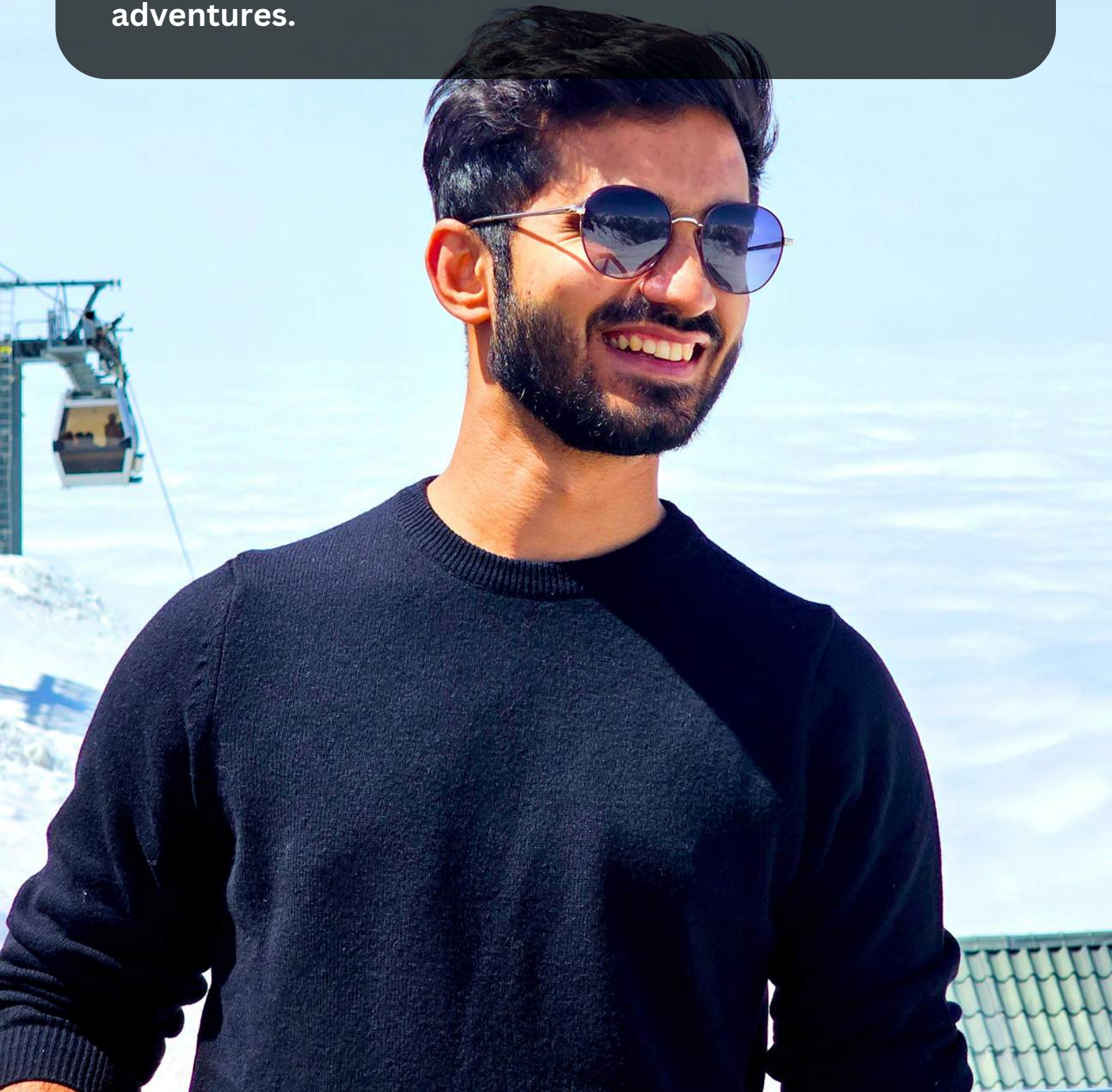
DAY 2




DAY 3

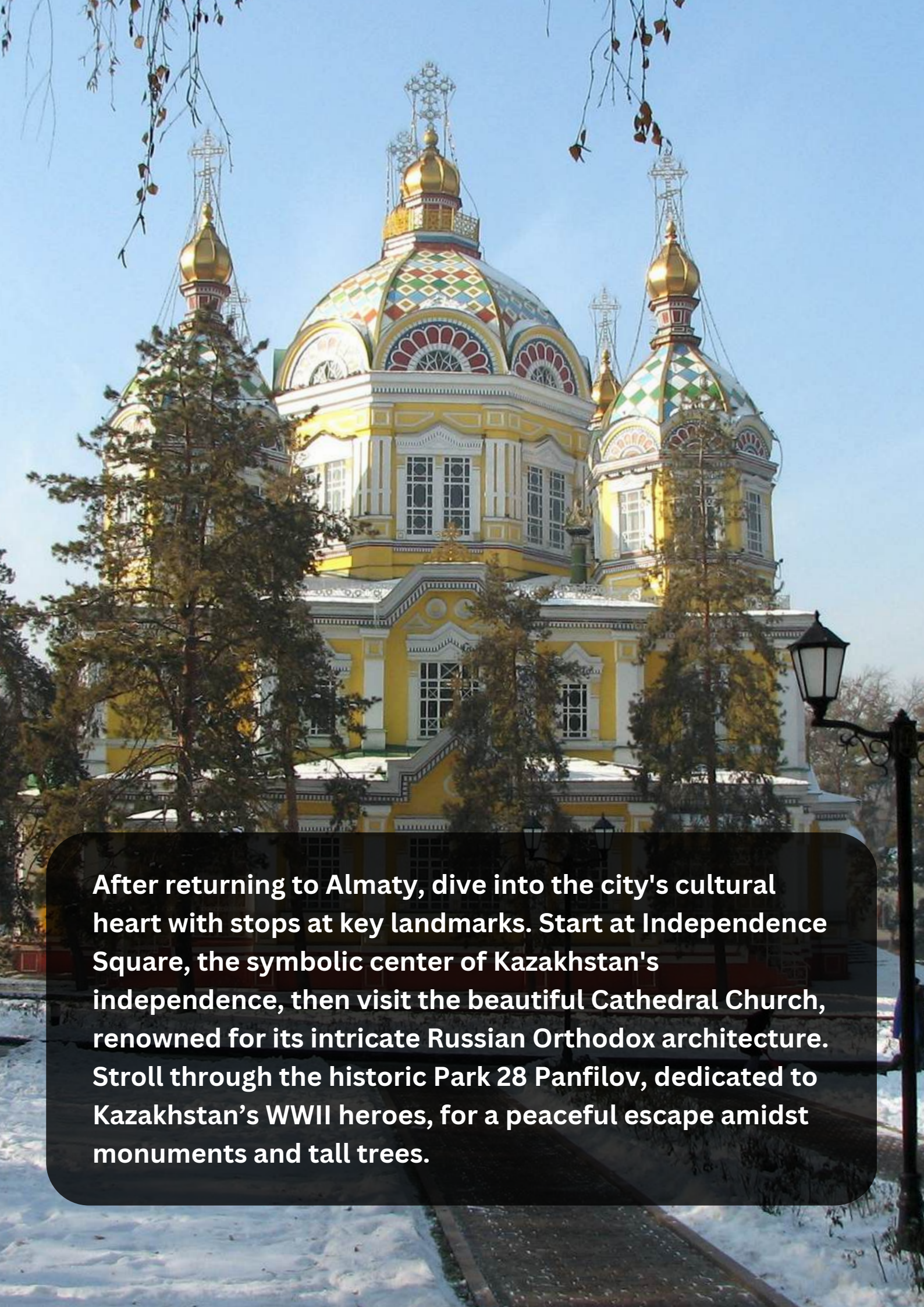

DAY 4

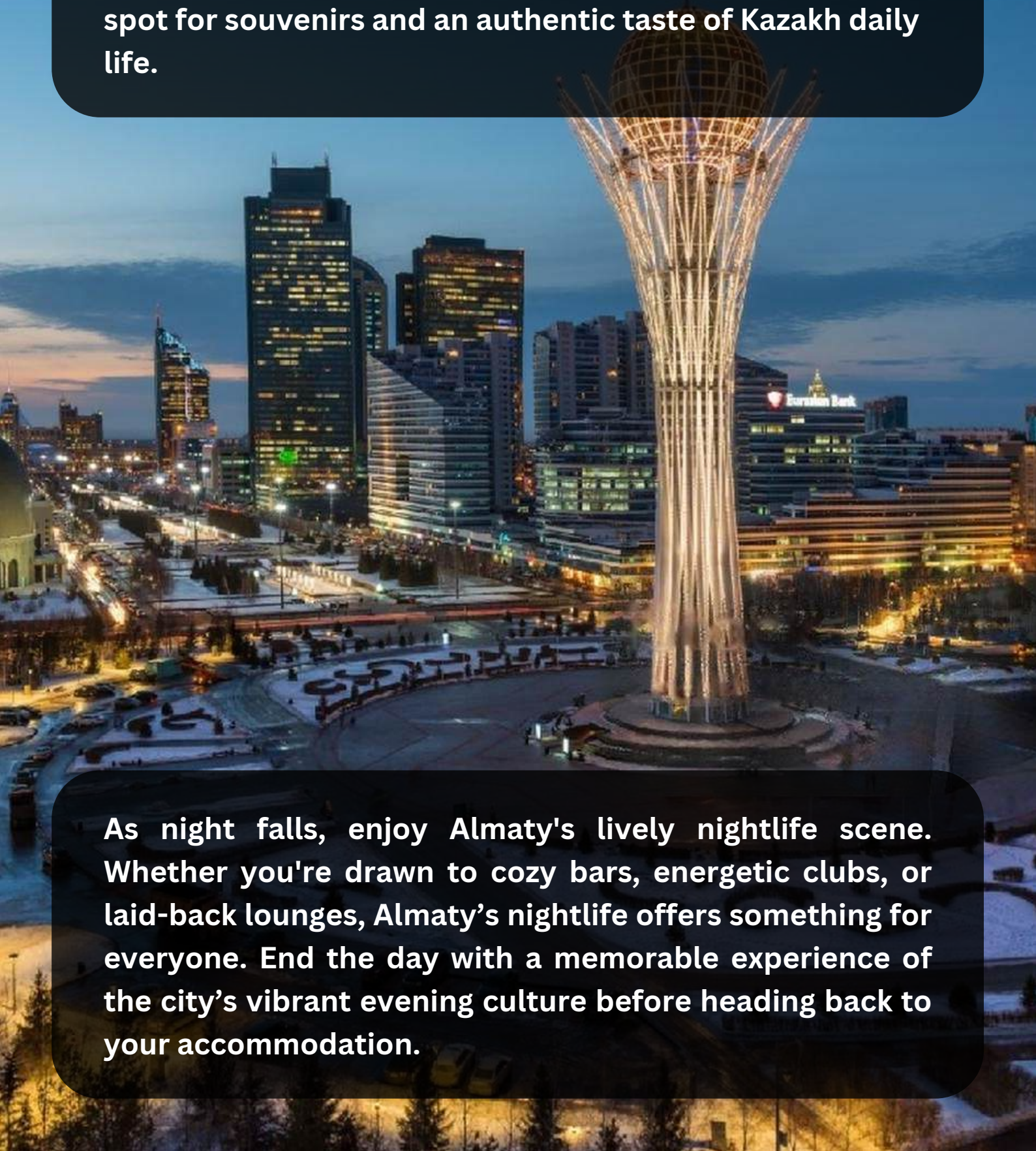
