


**Day 1:** Arrive in Shimla and





BUDDHA STATUE OF LANGZA





We will reach our hotel by night and post dinner, play a lot of fun games.





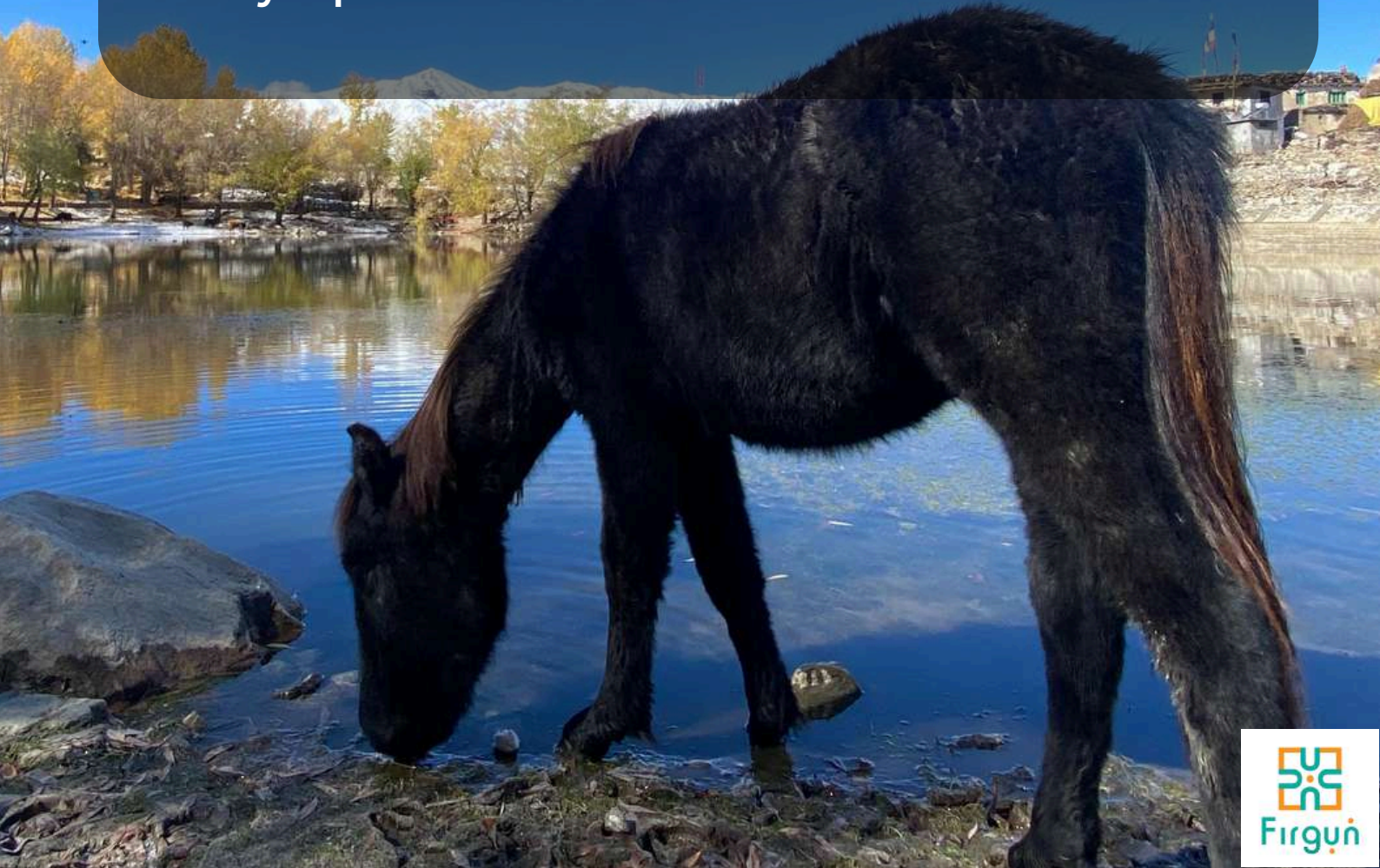
